The DuPage County Division of Transportation (DuDOT) cordially invites you to attend a public information meeting at the **Butterfield Park District**, **21W730 Butterfield Road**, **Lombard**, **IL 60148** on **Tuesday**, **April 29**, **2025**, **from 4 to 7 p.m.** concerning the preliminary engineering and environmental study for the East Branch DuPage River Trail (EBDRT) in the Villages of Glen Ellyn and Lombard in DuPage County. Written comments and survey responses received by May 16, 2025, will become part of the official public information meeting record.
